

## RV Parking – 2026 R5S Cordele, GA

The County and airport management has built us very nice RV parking facilities. As of June 2021, the contest management has now been given complete authority to sell, provide, or assign you with a RV parking spot. Contact Chris Carter (770-843-4099) for a space assignment. It will be possible to pre-pay for camping during contest registration, based on the number of nights you anticipate being in your spot. With this said, there are a few rules that we've observed over the years that you should still be aware of:

1. We will continue with the FBO practice regarding assignment of spaces. The only assigned spaces are the old upper 9 spaces to the immediate left of the contest office (on grass hill). These spaces are mainly provided to the contest management and a few grandfathered pilots, so if you see one open when you arrive, and unless you've been specifically assigned one of those spaces, do not plan on parking there. You will be required to move. Upon your arrival to the parking area, you'll select a parking space on a first come first serve basis (in the lower gravel lot) with water and 50-amp power. If you are 30-amp or less, you'll need a reducer from 50-amp. Be advised that these conditions could change, but this has been consistent for the past couple of years since the new parking was developed.
2. There is a formal driveway for the gravel parking lot just as you arrive at the parking area. Please **DO NOT** cut across the grass to the parking except via the driveway; unless you have an upper old space. Note: you will actually cut across a bit of grass to get to the driveway. It should be obvious – signs will be posted.
3. You may use your RV to move about the airport, but make sure you have a hand-held radio to monitor. Should we have to launch on Runway 24 and you want your RV at the launch point, you may follow the rest of the traffic and park to the east of the runway with other vehicles. You are responsible for making arrangements to get it moved back to the assembly area or RV parking after the launch.
4. There is **NO** grey water leaching. The contest will attempt to provide grey and/or black water dumping for a fee (amount TBD) by a local service (they are not consistently willing to do this). We will announce at the Pilot's Meeting if this is available. If it is, it is scheduled and not on-demand so sign up and prepay at the contest office. Additionally, there are a couple of full-service RV parks near Cordele if you desire continuous septic experience at

your site. Also, there is fee dumping (approx. \$10) at the Love's station at the airport Exit 102 as well as at the Pilot station one exit south (Exit 101) in Cordele. If you have a Pilot membership card, dumping is discounted as is fuel.

5. If you take your RV to your trailer for assembly, make sure you are not interfering with other pilots. Also, please do not park in front of portable toilets and the dumpster. No vehicles or assembly should be in front of these facilities.
6. If you bring a towed automobile, please park it in front of your RV to give you neighbor room to set outside their RV with an awning out. There is room. If you put an awning out, please tie it down. Storms could pop up during the day and could put your awning at risk.
7. If you are asked to move by airport management or contest management (we do have that authority), please just do it without debate. Thank you.
